Cian Nugent's first widely available album *Doubles* was released in the summer of 2011 to great acclaim from Pitchfork, NPR and *The Wire*, and rightly so. Nugent's playing is a glorious thing – it twists and turns as if telling a story, with each chord change revealing something new. Over the past year, the young Dublin-based guitarist linked up with a 4-piece band called The Cosmos, a motley bunch interested in mining the same far out musical styles. *Born With The Caul* is their first studio album and the group is a force, existing some place out of time. Not only is their sound an era-less one but the songs themselves are never in a hurry as they build and unfold, never wasting a note. Tours of the United Kingdom and Europe have clearly tightened them up, though the looseness and fluidity of their playing is an envious thing. *Born With The Caul* captures an artist and a group at a peak moment.
