Portland quartet **Houndstooth** make a sophomore jump with their second album, *No News from Home* - returning one part leaner than on their 2013 debut, *Ride Out the Dark*, the band's chief weapons — songwriting guitarists **Katie Bernstein** and **John Gnorski**, drummer-producer **Graeme Gibson** — remain intact, which is why a band that was so good out of the gate has only redoubled its powers, evolving into a deeper version of itself.
